Cub Scouting is a Family and Community based activity that is administered and run by volunteer Leaders, usually the parents of the boys who are members of each Pack. In order to provide your son with a program of the highest quality and standards, our Pack needs your input and participation.

By volunteering to become part of our Pack Leadership Team, you are insuring that our Pack delivers the most fun and the full *Promise of Scouting* to your son and the sons of our Pack Family.

In each case, all of the necessary training and program materials are provided to each member of our Pack Leadership Team at no cost, and at a minimum time requirement. In many cases, the required training is available to complete on-line at each individual's convenience.

The table below highlights some of the main volunteer positions needed to support our Pack program during the course of our Cub Scout year. The "percentage point values" associated with each duty position help each volunteer to gain an understanding of important contribution of all members of our Pack Leadership Team. These percentage values were formulated by our local Council professional staff, and take into account the responsibilities and time commitment required for each position. It is our hope that every member of our Pack Family can contribute at least 40% to the delivery of our program.
