Grades 1 through 3

- 1. Read, commit to, and sign the Level I Internet Safety Pledge. (BSA Cyber Chip blue card)
- 2. Watch the video “Bad Netiquette Stinks.” (<http://www.netsmartz.org/scouting>)
- 3. Play the Router’s Birthday Surprise Interactive Adventure, and print the completion certificate to give to your Den Leader. (<http://www.netsmartz.org/scouting>)
- 4. Show and tell your family, Den Leader, Den, or Pack what you have learned.

Grades 4 and 5

- 1. Read, commit to, and sign the Level I Internet Safety Pledge. (BSA Cyber Chip blue card)
- 2. Watch the video “The Password Rap” and another video of your choosing. (<http://www.netsmartz.org/scouting>)
- 3. As an individual or with your Den, use the Teachable Recipes to demonstrate Internet safety rules to your Den Leader, Den, or Pack. (<http://www.netsmartz.org/scouting>)
- 4. Discuss with your Unit Leader the acceptable standards and practices for using allowed electronic devices, such as phones and games, at your meetings and other Scouting events.
